

he dared to speak about their coming. Bear in mind the jet stream is normally not supposed to come down, yet, when it does meteorologists normally associate this with freak winds. Before the first major tornado to hit the downtown of a major modern U.S. city, in winter of 1996, or any series of jet streams came tumbling down unexpectedly, the announcement of a future world fright with weird jet stream activity, part of a bunch of devastating geo-physical events, was described in remote viewing missions outside the world of the average person.

In my view, I have come to the conclusion that Technical Remote Viewing is real indeed after following a trail of his foretelling, for lack of a better word, during 11 long years of research, of strong magnetic storms, of pigeons affected by solar region 8370, the SW and the Midwest crowned by strange new tornadoes (once considered very strange as late as 1995) and the continued occurrences of just plain freaky weather. It seems since 1996, there has been an increased intensity of all kinds of geologic and atmospheric problems all over the world. The strong magnetic attraction that has had a hold on me ever since 1996 were the increasing anomalies in our weather; they are the technical culprit I blame for keeping a curious hold on me and not releasing me. Major Dames is synonymous with Technical Remote Viewing.

I think the most profound prognostication he ever made was a strangely recent one. It involves the chilling story of a Boeing 767 jetliner that crashed 60 miles south of Nantucket, Massachusetts, in October of 1999 killing all 217 aboard. During the night of Thursday, November 11, 1999, Maj. Dames came on the air and made several startling statements that were so unbelievable it made me doubt him. He did not have access to any airline black box nor have any reason to be politically motivated; in fact, the flight data recorder was not found yet, and would not be recovered from the depths of the deep of the Atlantic Ocean until the following weekend.

The fate of EgyptAir Flight 990 was remote-viewed, and Dames said: “There was a violent altercation in the cockpit, Art. One of the crew members, or it could have been a flight attendant attacked the pilot from behind. There was a very violent altercation [that] followed, part of members of the crew tried to hold down a single individual, but the individual got up again. And started essentially...went postal in the cockpit, that is why when the cockpit voice recorder is retrieved, you will hear that in the recorder.” Dames said it was a male that attacked the pilot. Passengers were

oblivious to the fighting, and added either a crew member or flight attendant brought the jet down and not a rampaging passenger or engine malfunction or missile. This was an exceptional example of alerting the public before the investigators made their public findings, I now realize. [See *The Atlantic Monthly*, 11-2001.]

All the news media and the world press covered the “findings” in detail the following week or so. My friend Gary upon hearing from me the story of what Dames remote-viewed, said, “Aw, they will go to any heights. They could say anything, Dames is an entrepreneur. How do you know he didn’t say what he did afterwards? Just because someone said he said it on the radio does not necessarily mean...they can say anything, even that he said it before.” I told Gary I had the opportunity to hear him live that Thursday night. And I recorded it. And there was no chance anybody can say he said it after because I and millions who heard it live on Art Bell’s program witnessed it. Gary tilted his head, speechless. But, let’s not get ahead of ourselves.

As stated, I did not become aware of those profound technical remote-viewing (TRV) techniques until 1996. Believe me, in the beginning I did not believe in this thing called remote-viewing. I only monitored this whole TRV business. I stress the fact that it does not seem believable. It has and still does seem to be a mysterious, magical-like technique.

Major Edward Arthur Dames, recipient of the Legion of Merit from the U.S. Army, paratrooper, specialist in bio-electronics and Chinese, was targeting officer and the training officer for TRV. He is an astute intelligent man who retired from the military and was primarily in military intelligence. He was connected with MJ-5, a once-top secret group that investigated and validated UFO objects in northern New Mexico. When he retired in the late 1980s he went public and formed his own private company called PSI Tech, technically an extension of what he did in the field of military remote-viewing but, outside the confines of military bureaucracy. TRV was so top secret nobody ever heard of it. The United Nations once secretly asked for PSI Tech’s help using Technical Remote Viewing in locating Saddam’s secret gas stockpiles in 1991. (Speaking of gas, he remote-viewed the Gulf War Syndrome. The genesis of it was Pyridostigmine-bromine tablets the troops were forced to take, according to Major Dames.) The stature of remote-viewing was untenably diminished when a 1995 CIA report was sneakily issued conclusively sounding and deceptively stating all remote viewing programs were duds.

Instead of sticking to special contracts with wealthy clients or military intelligence he expanded into biosphere stuff. Dames and company were conducting envi-

ronmental studies when in the mid 1990s they began to tell the whole world what they perceived. In 1994-95, he claims he and his colleagues at PSI Tech began to detect anomalies of the future course of the Earth. He believes we are due for something tremendous, so tremendous he calls it a break in human evolution—because it is global and deadly.

THE DEPTH OF REMOTE VIEWING IS ONLY BEGINNING

Periodically, Major Ed Dames has exclusively appeared on Art Bell's radio program, Coast to Coast AM with Art Bell. This program was heard Monday through Friday live in the late evening, 10 pm PST. It brings new and current news of information, some startling—some suspect by a skeptical me—and some weird and scary by anyone's standards. Art Bell began a meteoritic rise in popularity from 1996 that was daunted briefly in 1999—an incident involving his son took him out of radio briefly—but pinnacled in 2001, when his show reached 500 stations nationwide—a magical mark in the radio industry. Listeners are given a good source of information along a variety of topics, including news from scientists that you normally do not hear on the regular news channels. But anyone listening to Coast to Coast programs knows Art loves to light up a lantern filled with a bewildering illumination of the strange and the spooky. I myself never heard of Art Bell until 1996. For the most part, I would take it with a grain of salt.

The host, Art Bell, has five computers, is a master at electronics, the latest science information, weather and related sources of information, loves to dig into anything new or weird, including Egyptology, cancer, climatology, geology, the impact of UV radiation, cloning, UFO's, the occult, ghosts, and other strange things that he uses to make his program irresistible. But, it was by far not all opinion and hearsay.

He was one of the first to bring us word of the correct dimensions of such diverse topics as the Miami Circle, Pfiesteria, Ginger, the mobile geo-magnetic transportation device, and the dead zones in the Caribbean. Some people are born to follow; some to lead. He is a leader when it comes to telling you things before the rest of the world knows about it. Call it luck, call it charm, call it connections, call it what you will. He could tango with anyone. The variety of his guests are awesome, from the study of sono-luminescence to conversing with one of the greatest physics professors who ever lived, like Michio Kaku. His programs provided me and the listening world

astute economists, knew several years ago about those things. But, it is the content of specifics that he revealed that August that struck me most chillingly. He is not funny when he stated the U.S. economy was eroding in 1998 and, despite appearing strong, would topple in fashion like the economic collapse that occurred to the people in Asia, Latin America (especially Brazil), Russia, and the Balkans. Giving the accuracy of Maj. Dames the economic system is breaking down, –no one said it is down and out which it is not.

On August 31, let it be said Dames was asked about the status of our economy and he said, “right now our economy is sound.” Yet, he also said layoffs will increase; (and wished people would focus on that instead of focusing on the quandary of the spectacle of Monica. That August someone on the radio asked him about Fatima and he said that would be an interesting project...intriguing for the year 1998. It was not until a later program aired in November of 1998 that the information about what was remote-viewed on the Third Secret of Fatima was shared. Before we get into this we must first review some of the things he said, things you could say were prognosticated like some Nostradamus.)

ECONOMIC collapse?

A sudden worldwide collapse is not entirely impossible when you take in consideration that on any given day, according to John Major, the world is so interconnected economically that one trillion dollars can change hands overnight. But, it has not come to pass.

Maj. Dames said to watch out for the danger in long-term government bonds held by prosperous foreigners because the U.S. will default on paying those bonds. Tricky world, isn't it? The problems associated with economic collapse is not specifically textbook economic theory, but tie it to climate and fungus blight endangering world food, and a new symphony is possible. What combination of this would be so real and so terrible as to cause worldwide economic collapse to spread so far and so fast?

In terms of economy, it looked like a rosy picture for the U.S. in 1999; of all the industries, the entertainment industry seemed to be flourishing the best where billions of dollars are spent on entertainment, including the nueva mode: gambling and drugs. People seem to love to turn over their dough on each to get a new thrill; the drug trade spins in the mid 1990's dramatically. The drug trade was as one source said, “the single most lucrative business sector in the world,” of at least \$500 billion a year.

There is a unique phenomena that has hit the American culture. About 400 billion dollars a year is bet on U.S. sports, according to a report from Sixty Minutes, January 7, 2001. Dozens of new gambling casinos, moreover, now operate over and near the Mississippi River. Indian Reservation casinos all over the West, Midwest and East have sprung up, like the big Fox Woods and Mohegan casinos on the East. Unlimited state lottos allow you to gamble to your heart's content. Gambling is endemic around the United States, and it is not just a pernicious rise in Native American society. It appears beyond a skyline of Las Vegas and Atlantic City. Big developments are big time just like the 1890s, but with more glitzy glitter and of course a fortune in computer technology. During my father's generation, the WW II generation, neither the gambling trade or the drug trade were no where that big. Where, oh where is the global village of tomorrow being pointed to?

Every time Maj. Dames was announced to appear, I recorded his words. Keep in mind Maj. Dames gets annoyed when you think him to be some sort of swami or seer. He claims he does not predict the future nor is he into the New Age stuff. He claims TRV is more powerful than coordinate remote-viewing. He explains that he uses TRV to see what is hidden in the collective consciousness of the mind, reminding listeners constantly TRV is a "set of protocols that call the mind to events and things distant in the present," past or future time and space—beyond an interfering realm of imagination. TRV sounds like prophecy, but it is not. The protocols allow people to train themselves. Dames states TRV uses information that already exists, in a new term called the collective unconscious. Unfortunately, many of the things he mentions refer to a bleak picture.

Back on October 12, 1996, Maj. Dames made his famous announcement that something would affect the whole world: it was strange, geophysical and "non-pulsing." The military man also said on this date, "I don't scare easy..." but "there is something that is out there that happens" that is so scary "we [the world] change." He forewarned watch. "It is very eerie. It affects everybody on the planet." However, he and the PSI Tech team knew not what they were looking at. In October he did not fully understand all aspects of what he and his team were remote-viewing—a much clearer picture arose in January of 1997. Also, during that October program, he described how PSI Tech had first begun in 1994-95 to detect the future course of the Earth, and
