



1961 John H. Glenn is first American to orbit the Earth. First satellite relays live TV across oceans. First modem.

f June 27, 1963, eyewitness Archbishop Capovilla informs Pope Paul VI the location of the “Fatima package”, seemingly unimportant statement. Cassette tapes and Quasars discovered in 1963.

g The last of the annunciations by Our Blessed Lady in Garabandal, Spain, delivered by St. Michael because it pained the Blessed Virgin Mary too much to deliver it, on June 18, warns the cup of evil is overflowing, and this makes the last warning of Garabandal. (She had first appeared in Garabandal in 1961.) European tv stations and world papers cover it. No big miracle happens, but in this warning, it is warned that many bishops and priests are on the road to sinning and are taking many souls with them. The Franciscan Order has 2,251 young seminarians; the Catholic Church in the U.S. has 4.5 million students, 180,000 nuns, 126,000 baptisms, over 60,000 priests. Second Vatican Council (Vatican II) closes.

h Bishop of Fatima, Venancio, understands the need to defend the authentic messages of Our Blessed Mother and commences a learned Claretian priest Joaquin Alonso to thoroughly investigate history of Fatima. Restrictions on learning/writing are lifted, any Catholic can publish on Marian apparitions, without imprimatur, except Sister Lucia.

i Hollywood introduces system for rating their movies, including the rating of X for nastiness. U.S. National Debt = 909 billion.

j Akita prophecy: a message of a chastisement worse than the flood could converge on the whole of humanity. Skylab is launched. Internet is coined the following year.

k Rev Alonso publicly declares that Father Fuentes’ published interview of Sister Lucia in 1957 is true, and accurately reports her statements about the content of the Message of Fatima. That year his 800 page work on Fatima is suddenly stopped.

l America celebrates bicentennial. First Supercomputer in the world goes online, created by Cray. Pope John Paul II elected, in two years, the first Polish Pope, first pope to grant a TV interview, and places a large M, for Mary, on his coat of arms.

m In a private letter to Brother Michael in Brittany, France, Rev Schweigl replies that the 3rd Secret is composed of two parts; one concerns the Pope. No further details given. Vatican neither confirms or officially denies it.

n May 12, *L’Osservatore Romano* reveals interview between Rev. U. Pasquale and Sister Lucia about how important the consecration of Russia is, whereby the consecration of the world was never asked by the Blessed Virgin Mary; up to 1982, he had received 157 letters from Sister Lucia. They have known each other since 1939. Pope John Paul II consecrates “the world.”

o March 25, 1984, Pope John Paul II again consecrates “the world.” Nov. 11 issue of *Jesus* reports Cardinal Ratzinger stated Third Secret concerns the dangers of Faith.

p Key passages of *Jesus* magazine interview concerning the Faith are deleted from a new book *The Ratzinger Report*.

q First nurse contracts AIDS, accidentally in hospital. First stereo-sound TV. First e-book created by Franklin Co.

r Oct 11, Sister Lucia’s own blood sister, Carolina, tells Rev. Gruner in Fatima that her sister *does not know how to type*.
